

Leavenworth 2026 Rockfest Bouldering Competition

Format

The 2026 Rockfest bouldering competition will be an all day flexible group format designed to maximize cooperation from across the skill range within climbing. Teams will have no fixed size, instead teams must take the max guidebook grade each climber has accomplished add them together for a total of no more than 25 points.

Example:

- V2 + V3 + V4 + V5 + V11 = 25 points
- V12 + V13 = 25 points

Points will be total cumulatively across the group, highest point total wins. Special modifiers will be added to encourage as much diversity as possible in area and problem selection (see below).

Climbers/teams can begin registration at 8AM, comp starts at 9AM, scorecards must be turned in by 6PM.

Point Multipliers

1. If all members of the group climb the same problem it is worth 2x the total points in the final result
2. For every distinct area starting with the second are a group logs a team send (all team members climbed problem) a (+0.1) multiplier will be applied to the final sum.
 - a. For example if a group completed team sends at Fridge and Barneys Ruble, their final total would be multiplied by 1.1.
 - b. For example if a group completed team sends at Fridge, Forestlands, and Barneys Ruble, Mad Meadows and Slingblade their final total would be multiplied by 1.4.

Other Rules

1. All grades are guidebook grades, if there is a slash grade the lower of average of the two grades will be used.
2. All boulders must be topped out (unless guidebook specifies a drop off)
3. Boulders not in the guidebook must be capable of providing video evidence
4. No boulders with access issues that would prevent any team from climbing will be allowed into final total
